Welcome to the 27th annual Carlisle Import & Kit Nationals! It's been almost 30 years since the first show, and there sure have been a lot of changes. Last year marked some of the most significant changes to the show, and, as promised, they were all positive.

New for 2012 is the Downtown Carlisle Block Party on Friday evening. We have worked with the borough to bag the parking meters in the first two blocks of North Hanover Street. Those parking spaces are being reserved for you, the showfield participant. Just make sure you have your Import & Kit Nationals window sticker and/or your dash card. Either of these will allow you to park at the bagged meters Friday beginning at 5 p.m.

In addition to the preferred parking, there will be activities throughout Downtown Carlisle such as dining or visiting local shops and historic markers. You are free to wander on your own or you can visit Guest Services for a complete list of participating merchants.

The Passport Program was new last year and it was a success on many levels. It's back, bigger and better, for 2012. We also enjoyed great success with the French feature, thanks in large part to the Citroën, Renault and Peugeot clubs. We had one of the most diverse and interesting Invitational Displays in years. I can't remember the last time this show featured so many vehicles that were at least 100 years old.

We are trying to add atmosphere to the event without sacrificing the quality of the show. This is probably our most unique and diverse event, and we want to celebrate the numerous cultures that are represented on the field each year. In 2013, we will feature Swedish vehicles, so expect to see a record number of Volvos and SAABs.

When I was young, even before I got my first driver's license, I remember going to SCCA races at Cotati Raceway in northern California. Pressed into service as a corner worker, and holding a yellow flag while standing behind a bale of hay, I watched as 289 Cobras thundered by. With a list price of \$5,700, they were expensive then.

They are expensive today as well. You'd be lucky to find a good one for \$500,000, an amount that will buy you a pretty nice house in most areas of the country.

Merriam-Webster's definition of innovator is two-fold: the introduction of something new and/or a new idea, method, or device — a novelty. The term can best be used to describe two men who are spending their weekend with us. They were the minds behind something new, something different and something that remains popular within their respective enthusiast communities. Bruce Meyers and Alex Dearborn are two uniquely different men with a similar passion — autos!

ALEX DEARBORN

Alex Dearborn, designer and builder of the Deserter, is with us this weekend. The Deserters were born in the late '60s with the Series One model and ran through the GT version in '72. Alex's car career started during his military days in the 1960s. It wasn't long before he was working



for Ray Caldwell at Autodynamics. There, Alex designed the Deserter, a series of cars uniquely blending sports car and dune buggy with VW underpinnings. The original Deserter GS raced Pikes Peak in 1971, and examples were sold thereafter as kits. Stop by the Deserter Club Tent to talk with Alex and for autographs. See schedule.

BRUCE MEYERS

Bruce Meyers, father of the modern-day dune buggy, is joining us again this year. His long history dates back to the original water pumpers of Southern California. Meyers took it upon himself to redesign the crude, heavy vehicles into the lightweight version that we are accustomed to today. After being featured on the cover of national automotive

magazines such as Hot Rod and Car and Driver, The Meyers Manx took off in popularity across the country. Throughout the years, Meyers produced more than 7,000 kits stemming from the Manx. Talk with Bruce and get his autograph in Building T. See schedule.

BLOCK PARTY

New this year is the Downtown Carlisle Block Party. There will be reserved parking for showfield participants on North Hanover Street. Parking will be designated by bagged meters. Simply park your show car and display either your showfield dash card or your showfield window sticker.

AUTOCROSS

The Susquehanna Region of the Sports Car Club of America (SCCA) and its Chapter Club, the Appalachian Sports Car Club, will conduct practice sessions on Friday and autocross on Saturday and Sunday. Each participant will get three runs of three laps against the clock. Scoring will be done on an overall basis using an index designed to adjust for the performance capabilities of the different cars. The experience is designed to allow you to test your performance on the course. But it will also be useful if you simply want to learn more about your car's potential and your ability to manage it. Instructors will be available to ride along and help you explore new levels of performance for both you and your vehicle.



Registration is required at the SCCA tent next to the track. The charge for each entry is \$25. When you register, you will choose a specific session. There are eight drivers per session. Check in at least 30 minutes prior to your start time for sign-in and safety inspection. Participants must be at least 18 years old and have a current driver's license. Helmets are required; loaner

helmets are available. Registration closes when the sessions are filled.

SCENIC CRUISE

We'll provide the directions for you to take a self-guided tour of south central Pennsylvania on Saturday afternoon. The tour will take you off the beaten path and allow you to get a real taste of the Cumberland Valley. You do not need to be registered for the showfield; all guests are welcome to participate. Directions are available at GUEST SERVICES.



LIVE BANDS

Enjoy a variety of bands playing on the River 97.3 stage facing the showfield. On Friday, hear Jazz Me Rhythm & Blues Band and Fretworks; Saturday it's Jazz Me, Payton Taylor & Band (Nashville Country Music Sensation) and The Funktion Band; and Sunday see Payton Taylor & Band, No Last Call Band and Jazz Me Rhythm & Blues Band.

Teen drivers are accident-prone, not because they are bad drivers, but because they lack the experience needed to properly avoid danger. Because of that, and the staggering statistics associated with teen driving fatalities, local young drivers will have a FREE opportunity to better themselves behind the wheel.

Carl Heideman owns Eclectic Motorworks LLC in Michigan, a shop that specializes in service, restoration, sheetmetal work and performance upgrades for classic European and other interesting cars. Carl offers performance recipes for many classic imports based on data from more than 1,000 dyno pulls and tests of hundreds of performance parts during the past 20 years. Topics include ignition, carb and exhaust upgrades, internal engine modifications, fuel injection, supercharging and more. Applicable to many makes and models, much of the discussion is based on data from MGBs and Midgets.

HOW TO DESIGN A KIT CAR

Jim Simpson of Simpson Designs has developed several custom-bodied sports cars based on the sporty and reliable Mazda Miata. Jim will discuss how his company goes about designing a kit and what is involved in the process, from styling elements to materials and marketing. SMART CAR

An often-used adage for events at Carlisle is that if you don't see what you are looking for, you didn't look hard enough. About 99% of the time, that phrase suits all shows, from Spring and Fall Carlisle to the eight specialty shows in between. The exception, however, is for vehicles that are registered as part of the showfield for the Import & Kit Nationals. Whether this is your first year attending the show, you've been part of the weekend since its inception or you are somewhere in the middle, you know that there are a lot of cars to be seen. If you think you've seen, or found, all that is to be had at the Import & Kit Nationals, you're wrong!

The show, in existence since 1986, has many hidden gems. Annually you will see a BMW, FIAT, Volvo, Porsche, Ferrari and more, but it's a certainty that each year will bring something new, something rare and something that will make you feel like this event is truly one-of-a-kind. The one person who has seen a majority of cars on grounds is Event Manager Ed Buczeskie. During his time at Carlisle, either as an employee or enthusiast, Ed, more than many others, has taken notice to the one-of-a-kind rides that seem to always make their way to the Carlisle, PA, Fairgrounds.

"While about 90% of the vehicles at the Import & Kit Nationals would not be a common sight on the road on any given day, many of them are considered uncommon even to automotive enthusiasts," Buczeskie said. "Carlisle guests are treated to such rarities as the Auto Union DKW, Facel Vega Facellia, Simca 1000, Vespa 400, FIAT Autobianchini, Lancia Fulvia and Lamborghini Islero when they attend the Import & Kit Nation-

als." Buczeskie said that "even as rare as each of those vehicles may be, one of the rarest vehicles we've ever featured is the 1911 Breese Paris. Only two are known to exist."

Why would so many rare cars converge on one location for an event such as the Import & Kit Nationals? Buczeskie said, "I can't say for certain, but I think they come here because their cars are unique and they enjoy showing them to people who may not be very familiar with them." Buczeskie also believes that since "unique cars don't typically have shows just for that brand, this show gives them a home. Some of these cars are so rare and unique that it's difficult for them to have their own (stand-alone) event. The Import & Kit Nationals gives them the venue. I welcome these vehicles because they bring something truly unique to the show."

It's one thing to reflect on the cars that have previously been part of the event, but another to know that as you walk the grounds this weekend, you'll once again see a rare gem or two. Confirmed for the Import & Kit Nationals and at Carlisle this weekend are three Auto Union DKWs, a seldom-seen 1967 Lotus Elan, approximately five Deserters (there's a GT, an S-1 and a GC-GT) and several TVR 2500 Vixens.

So when you look at an event like the Import & Kit Nationals and think to yourself that it's just another car show — seen one, seem them all — you should think again. The third weekend in May provides you with not only an amazing array of international excitement, but also cars that you have either never seen before or ones that you have not seen in quite some time.

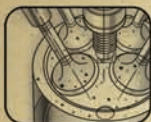

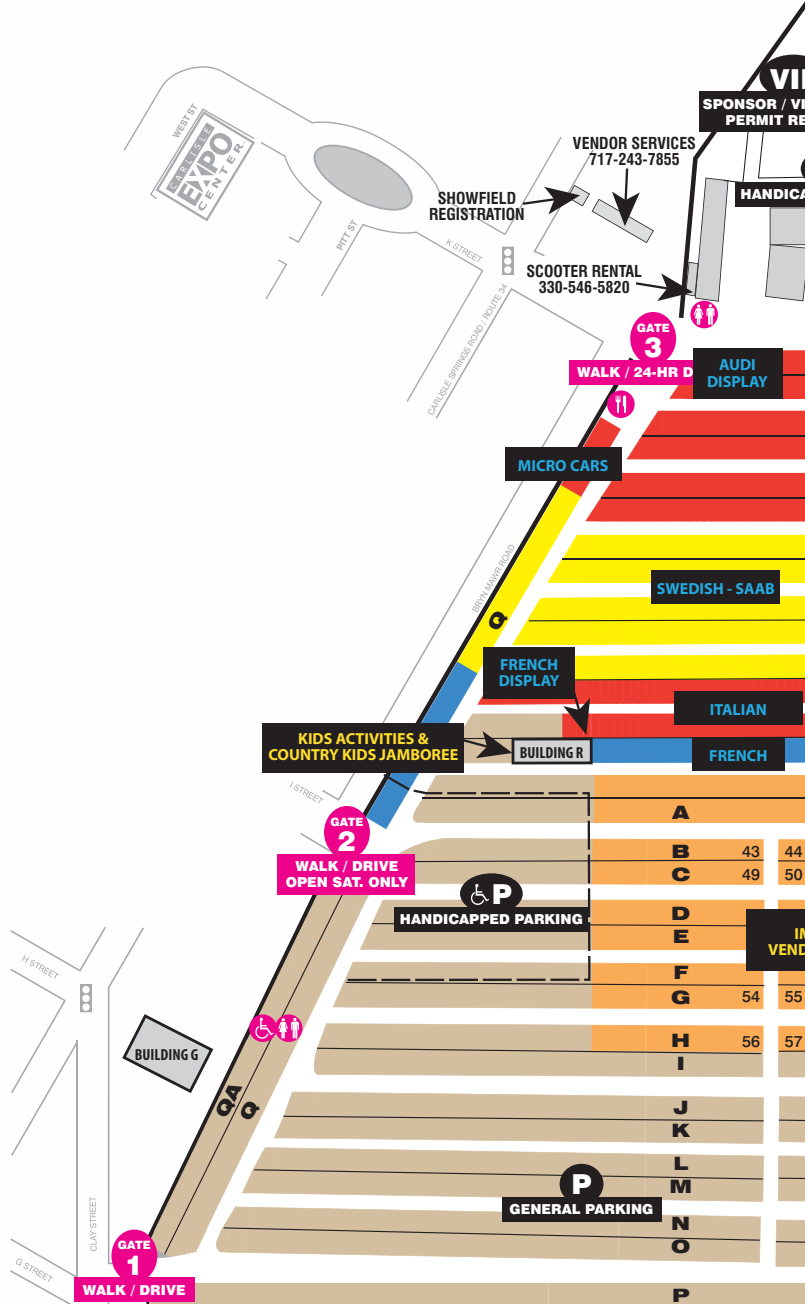

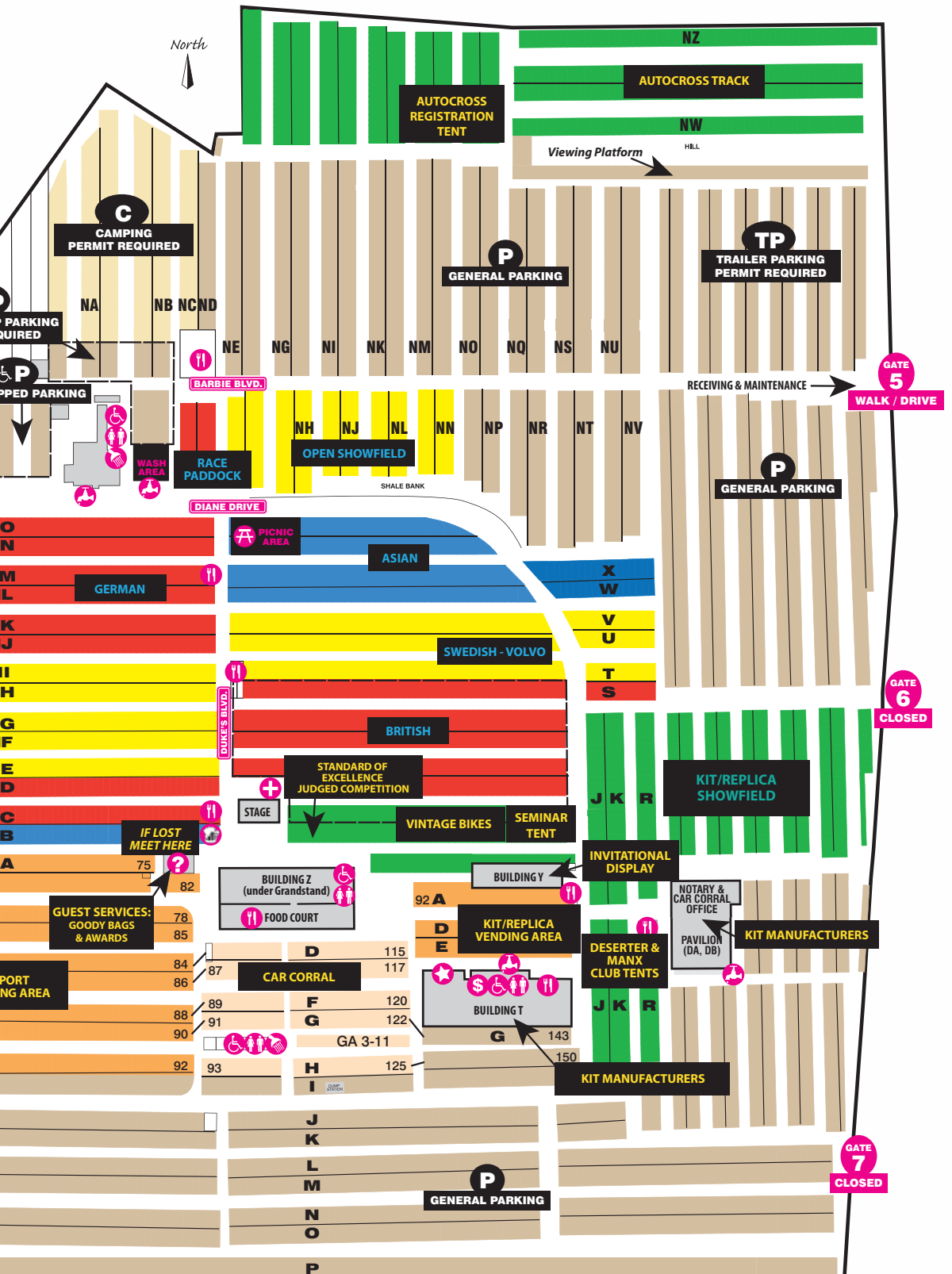

PASSPORT





Thirty years ago, there was a group called Fiat Club of America, founded by FIAT owner Santo Bimbo in New York. Santo ran a hand-typed correspondence newsletter that was mostly composed of letters from members who wanted to share their experiences of FIAT and Lancia cars. Santo wanted Fiat Club of America to remain a correspondence club, while some of his members wanted to get together to share the enthusiasm on road trips and gatherings. The original idea was to come up with a "Freak Sheet" to share information among like-minded members on a regular basis.

Enthusiasts Bobb Rayner and Dwight Varnes decided to meet in 1982 and discuss an idea for gathering like-minded enthusiasts in eastern Pennsylvania. Ironically, it was the same year that FIAT and Lancia distribution ceased in North America. Bobb and Dwight met, and along with Scott Hill, Jim Manbeck, Tracy Harber, Mike Becciarini, Brian Sullivan, Steve Bruck and a few others, formed a small group. The original name of the new club was Fiat Lancia Underground, or "FLU," because it had no affiliation with FIAT S.p.A. and they were on their own without factory support. Scott Hill designed a FLU logo that was inspired from the top of a peanut butter jar lid!

The club grew quickly and decided to print their own newsletter to announce events, post member



stories and offer helpful tech tips. Dues were \$5 per year. The newsletter was still hand-typed and copied, but it was a great way to spread the word. Brian Sullivan did a great job as illustrator to add more zing to the publication. Meanwhile, vendors in the FIAT parts business wanted to put ads in the newsletter. Three early ones were International Auto Parts, Bayless (Midwest-Bayless) and Fiat Plus (C. Obert & Co). These fine vendors are still with us today.

Throughout the years, the club grew, and chapters began to form in places such as Detroit (which already had an established group), Western New York Southern Ontario (WNYSO) and Blue Ridge. Eventually, more than 25 chapters joined the ranks. Bobb and Dwight put together a summer meeting for Fiat Lancia Underground in 1983 at Pocono Raceway and named the show FIAT FreakOut. Since then, the FIAT FreakOut has grown to become the annual event that members enjoy from all over the world. The show moved from its modest beginnings to Hagerstown, MD, then eventually to more than a dozen places throughout the eastern United States, including Poughkeepsie, NY; Fontana, NC; Grand Island, NY; Dunkirk, NY; Canaan Valley, WV; Asheville, NC; Osage Beach, MO; Detroit and finally back to the Poconos for the 25th Anniversary FreakOut in 2008. They met in Valley Forge, PA, and once again in Asheville, NC, in 2010.

The club decided to change its name to Fiat Lancia Unlimited in 1986 to welcome all Italian automobiles and widen its appeal to enthusiasts all over the world. The club magazine became more professional and on glossy paper after club members Darryl and Deb Stacey took over production. Brett Melancon took over for Darryl and Deb in 1997. The magazine was called Ricambi and featured columns by Dwight, Bobb, Scott Hill, Jim Aitken, Joel Hailey, and members who gladly shared their wonderful adventures with FIAT and Lancia automobiles.

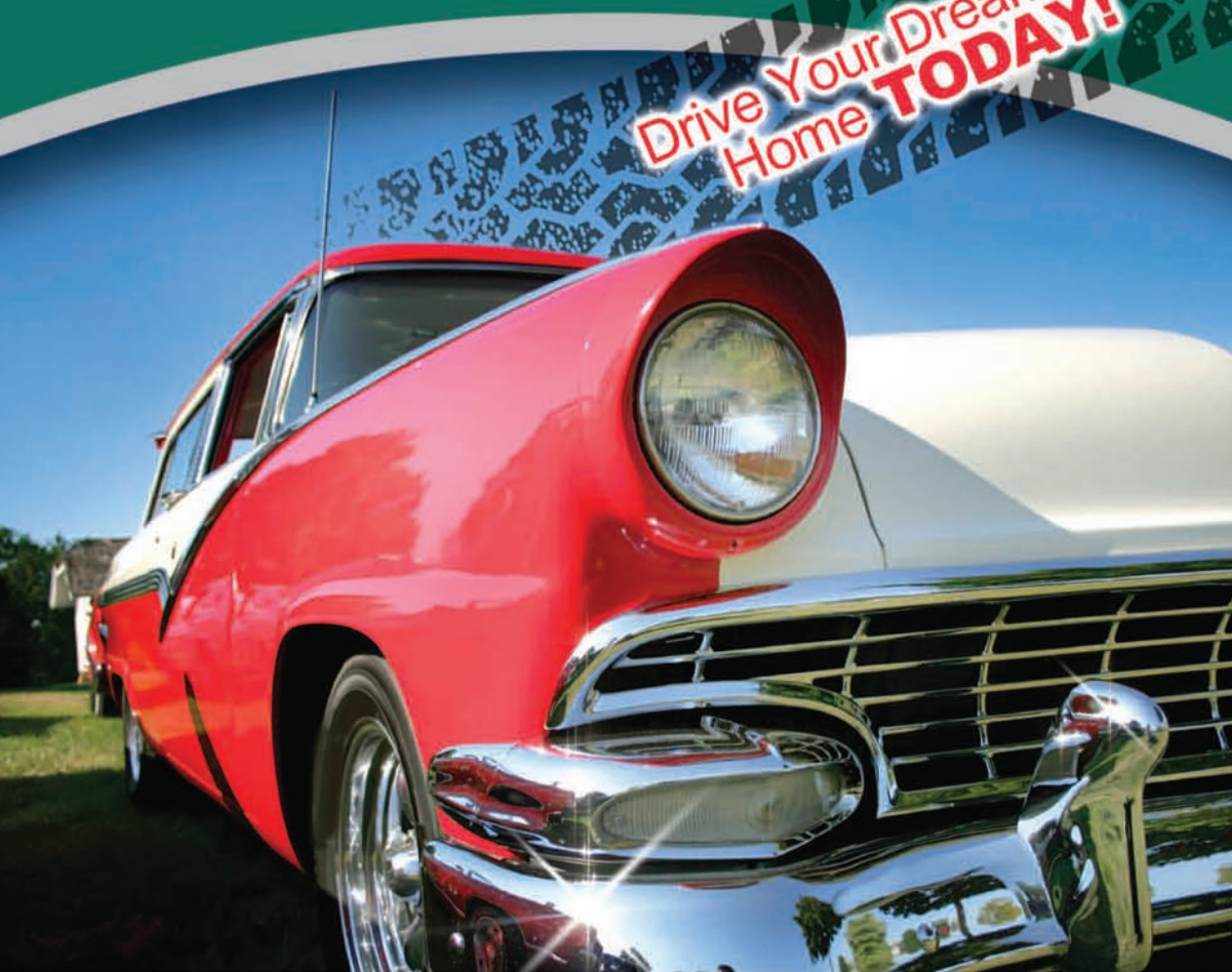

An estimated 595,000 feet of paper towels are used during an event season. That equates to nearly 113 miles! That is greater than the driving distance from Carlisle to Harrisburg, Philadelphia, Scranton, Wilkes-Barre, York and even across the state line down to Annapolis, MD.

FACT 2: To fill those nearly 600 blue trash barrels, more than 39,500 50-gallon trash bags are used. That means at least 1,975,000 gallons of trash get moved from point A to B between April and October.

FACT 1: Over the course of a season, more than 311 tons — 622,000 pounds — of trash is extracted from the hundreds of blue trash barrels. This total does not include batteries, liquids, tires and metal.

Next up is a breakdown of how much temporary fencing and how many fence posts are used in a season. If you lined up each piece of fencing, you could travel to many points within the 17013 ZIP code.

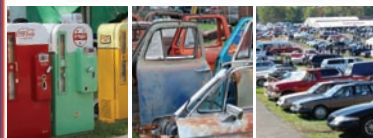
